AWJ Scholarship For Women

Applicants Must:

- Be a full-time college junior or senior in the academic year for which the scholarship is used and attend a college in Texas.
- Major in print, broadcast or photojournalism.
- Have a 2.5 grade-point average in major.

With the completed application, please send:

- Grade transcripts from all universities or colleges attended.
- Three samples of print, broadcast work or photographs.
- A one-page letter of recommendation from an instructor or adviser familiar with the applicant's work.
- A statement of professional goals and how the scholarship will help. Include information about financial need, if that is a factor. Statement should be no more than two pages.
- Stamped, self-addressed envelope if materials are to be returned.

Scholarship payment will be sent directly to the university for tuition.

Completed application and the material outlined at left must be post-marked by March 3, 2006. Send to AWJ Grant, Box 2199, Fort Worth, TX 76113. Up to four scholarships of \$1,000 each will be presented at AWJ's annual spring banquet. Copies of this form are also available at www.awjdfw.org.
